Civil Engineering Cadetship (readvertised)

LEGS Port Macquarie is offering one (1) civil engineering cadetship opportunity for a student completing the HSC in 2009. Consideration will also be given to mature age students such as those currently studying civil engineering as an undergraduate.

Terms and conditions of Civil Engineering Cadetship

Full time work at LEGS Port Macquarie as a civil engineering cadet with part-time external study for the Associate Degree in Civil Engineering through the University of Southern Queensland (Toowoomba) without needing to leave Port Macquarie.

The Cadet will be employed under the conditions of the Draughting Employees, Planners, Technical Employees etc State Award, with wages in accordance with the LEGS Salary System (currently \$568.10 per week for a first year cadet rising to \$714.00 per week for a fourth year cadet), plus bonuses, university fees and study leave and other benefits including on the job training in real engineering projects.

The Associate Degree is a four year part-time course. It represents exactly one half of a full engineering degree at USQ, and on completion of the cadetship, a student can decide to complete the degree course in his/her own time.

Payment of University Fees

Local Government Engineering Services Pty Ltd will pay the university tuition fees (but not book fees or other extra expenses, and provided that the cadet passes enrolled subjects). But in exchange the Cadet will be required to enter an agreement with LEGS to serve for the term of the cadetship and for a minimum additional two year period after completion of the Associate Degree. Current rates of pay for an Associate Degree graduate under the LEGS Salary System are \$868 per week for the first year and \$885.500 for the second year.

Study leave and study supervision

The Cadet will be entitled to study leave of one day per week at full pay during each academic year up to a maximum of 36 days per year.

Study leave will usually be taken at the LEGS office under the supervision and tuition of a qualified civil engineer.
